1. Audited Financial Results

The Board of Directors has considered and approved the Standalone Audited Financial Results of the Company for the half year and financial year ended 31st March, 2026. A copy of the said Standalone Audited Financial Results along with the Independent Auditor's Report thereon is enclosed herewith.

Further, pursuant to Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we hereby confirm that the Statutory Auditors of the Company have issued an Audit Report containing an unmodified opinion on the Standalone Audited Financial Results of the Company for the financial year ended 31st March, 2026.

2. Recommendation of Dividend

Report on the Audit of the Financial Results

We have audited the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March, 2026 and reviewed the Financial Results for the half year ended 31st March, 2025, 30th September, 2025 & 31st March, 2026 (refer 'Other Matter' section below), which were subject to limited review by us, both included in the accompanying "Statement of Standalone Financial Results for the Half year and Year Ended 31st March, 2026 of "Recode Studios Limited" (Formerly Recode Studios Private Limited) (the "Company"), (the "Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 and Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "LODR Regulations").

Auditor's Opinion

- (a) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March, 2026;
- are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 and Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015-, as amended; and
 - gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profits and other financial information of the Company for the year then ended.

(b) Conclusion on unaudited Financial Results for the half years ended 31st March, 2025, 30th September, 2026 & 31st March, 2026

With respect to the Financial Results for the half year ended 31st March, 2025, 30th September, 2025 & 31st March, 2026, based on our review conducted as stated in paragraph (b) of Auditor's Responsibilities-section below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March, 2026, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 and Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.



Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (“SA”s) specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “Act”). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in paragraph (a) of Auditor’s Responsibilities section below. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (the “ICAI”) together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March 2026 under the provisions of the Act and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the ICAI’s Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Management’s and Board of Directors’ Responsibilities for the Statement

This Statement which includes the Financial Results is the responsibility of the Company’s Board of Directors and has been approved by them for the issuance. The Financial Results for the year ended 31st March 2026 has been compiled from the related audited financial statements. This responsibility includes the preparation and presentation of the Financial Results for the half year ended and year ended 31st March 2026 that give a true and fair view of the net profits and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 and Regulation 52 of the LODR Regulations. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Financial Results that give a true and fair view and is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. In preparing the Financial Results, the Board of Directors is responsible for assessing the Company’s ability, to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors is also responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the Company.

Auditor’s Responsibilities

(a) Audit of the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March 2026

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Financial Results for the year ended 31st March 2026 as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor’s report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if,



individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Financial Results.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Annual Financial Results, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Company's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Board of Directors.
- Evaluate the appropriateness and reasonableness of disclosures made by the Board of Directors in terms of the requirements specified under Regulation 33 and Regulation 52 of the LODR regulations.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the Board of Directors' use of the going concern basis of accounting and based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the ability of the Company to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the Statement or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the Annual Financial Results, including the disclosures, and whether the Annual Financial Results represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

Materiality is the magnitude of misstatements in the Annual Financial Results that, individually or in aggregate, makes it probable that the economic decisions of a reasonably knowledgeable user of the Annual Financial Results may be influenced. We consider quantitative materiality and qualitative factors in (i) planning the scope of our audit work and in evaluating the results of our work; and (ii) to evaluate the effect of any identified misstatements in the Annual Financial Results.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.



(b) Review of the Financial Results for the half year ended 31st March, 2025, 30th September, 2025 & 31st March, 2026

We conducted our review of the Financial Results for the half year ended 31st March 2026 in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (“SRE”) 2410 ‘Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity’, issued by the ICAI. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company’s personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with SAs specified under section 143(10) of the Act and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Other Matter

- The Statement includes the results for the Half year ended 31st March, 2025, 30th September, 2025 & 31st March, 2026. Figures for the Half year ending on 31st March 2025 have been obtained from the audited books of the year ended 31st March 2025, which were not audited by us. Hence, we have relied on the work of the previous auditor. While the figures of the half years ended 30th September 2025 and 31st March 2026 have been obtained from audited figures of the current financial year. Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
