O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Sanjay Hegde, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner-company and Mrs. Ginny Jetley Rautray, learned counsel appearing on caveat for the respondent.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 02nd November, 2026.
3. Till further orders, the debarment order dated 17.03.2026 passed by the respondent, against the petitioner-company will remain stayed.

4. The impugned order to the extent it stays the order of the learned Arbitrator, which in turn stayed the order of debarment dated 17.03.2026, will also remain stayed to that extent.

5. We make it clear that this order and the pendency of this Special Leave Petition will not prevent the learned arbitrator from proceeding with the matter.

6. We, however, stay further proceedings before the High Court in ARB.A.(COMM.) No. 61/2026, till further orders.

7. An early resolution of the dispute before the learned Arbitrator may put an end to the whole controversy.

8. Subject to the calender of the learned Arbitrator, the learned Arbitrator may make an endeavour to complete the proceedings as early as possible.

9. Let counter affidavit be filed on or before 16.10.2026.

10. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed thereafter, before the next date of hearing.
