UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners and learned Solicitor General of India, representing the State Bank of India.
2. In view of the fact that some similarly placed home-buyers, constituting RNA Viva Residents Association, have already approached the Bombay High Court through Writ Petition (L) No.32849/2026, we dispose of this Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to also approach the Bombay High Court.

3. We also grant liberty to the petitioners that, owing to the nature of urgency, a mentioning may be made before the Bombay High Court during the course of the day for entertaining their Writ Petition and/or prayer for any *interim* relief.

4. It goes without saying that the High Court may consider such request as per its own merits. We have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.

5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
