O R D E R

1. Our order dated 19.03.2026 reads thus:-

" 1. We heard Mr. Kunal Tandon, the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner - RBL Bank Limited and Mr. Abhinav Malhotra, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent Nos 1 & 2 respectively.

2. We also heard Mr. Dhruv Joshi, the learned counsel assisted by Ms. Priya Nayyar, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent No.3 - DCB Bank Limited.

3. The learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner brought to our notice that the Bank has inter alia entered into a settlement with the respective husbands of the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 respectively, namely, Yogesh Patidar and Mr. Prashant Patidar. According to him, as per the understanding and the settlement, they have agreed to pay a sum of Rs.13.50 Crore towards full and final settlement. The settlement between the Bank and the Patidars has been reduced into writing. Out of the total sum of

Rs.13.50 Crore, an amount of Rs.3 Crore has been paid till this point of time. The balance payment has to be made by the Patidars on or before 20-6-2026. This payment has to be made in accordance with Clause 13.C of the Settlement Agreement.

4. Post this matter for further hearing on 30-7-2026.

5.The interim order earlier granted to continue."

2. Today, when the matter was taken up for further hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the parties jointly submitted that the matter has been fully settled between the parties and these petitions need not now be adjudicated further on merits.

3. This Special Leave Petitions are accordingly disposed of.

4. Interim order(s) passed by this Court on 19.12.2025 stands vacated.

5. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
