Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of SEBI (LoDR) Regulations 2015, kindly note the following Development in relation to an ongoing Material Litigation already disclosed in the offer documents of the Company:

This is in reference to the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No. 3720 of 2017 filed under section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 before the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand against the State of Jharkhand and the labour enforcement officer, Dhanbad ("LEO"), for quashing of the order dated December 16, 1998 passed by the chief judicial magistrate in a case filed under section 29 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. The LEO had filed a complaint before the chief judicial magistrate alleging non-implementation of an award dated July 20, 1992 ("Complaint").

The aforesaid Criminal Miscellaneous Petition No. 3720 of 2017 has been dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to raise grounds before the appropriate court or before the appropriate authority vide Order dated 07.05.2026.

The company shall take appropriate steps in accordance with law. It is the contention of the company that the award is not implementable.
