4      18-09-2026                      The learned counsel for the opposite parties submits that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 01.02.2022 passed in CWJC No.18738 of 2018, the admitted dues totaling to a sum of Rs.1,28,36,453/-, after deduction of the tax amount



has already been paid to the petitioner. It is submitted that the net amount paid to the petitioner after deduction of the tax amount totals up to a sum of Rs.1,11,67,712/-, thus it is submitted that the order of this Court has stood complied with.

2. We find that neither the learned counsel for the petitioner has bothered to appear nor any rejoinder has been filed to the show cause filed by the opposite parties so as to rebut the aforesaid contention made by the opposite parties, hence we are satisfied that the order of this Court dated 01.02.2022 has stood complied.

3. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed
