O R D E R

At the outset, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners submits that there is some confusion with regard to the proportion in which the petitioners and the State have to bear the burden depending on whether the post is partly or fully aided/funded by the State Government.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that the post is 100% State-aided and thus, the liability would be that of the State Government.

3. Learned counsel for the State fairly submits that he has to take instructions on the factual aspects, including the status of the post since November 2025, the date from which the Government has to pay the salary/wages to respondent No. 1, the date from which respondent No. 1 has been reinstated against the post, and the proportion of aid which the State is obliged to provide in respect of the post which respondent No. 1 has held since 2009, having regard to the grant-in-aid given to the school from 2015 onwards.
