1. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties and interacted with Mr. Naresh Walke, Secretary, District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Gondia. We have also interacted with Mr. Abhay Patil, Secretary of the appellant-Yuvak Gramin Vikas Shikshan Sanstha and with the respondent-Ms. Sharda Anandrao Paradkar.

2. The parties are *ad-idem* that the matter has been amicably

resolved in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 28.07.2026.

The terms of settlement are as under:

"We, the undersigned, are entering into the agreement based on the following terms and conditions:

1) Petitioner No.1: Yuvak Gramin Vikas Shikshan Sanstha, Sarandi, Taluka Tiroda, District Gondia,

2) Will pay to Respondent No.4 Ku.Sharada Anandrao Paradkar, lump-sum amount of Rs.18,00,000 (Rupees Eighteen lakhs) towards salary for the period commencing from 27/07/2016 until the date of her retirement (on 31/03/2026) as under.

3) On the date of agreement, payment of Rupees Three Lakhs Sixty Thousand will be made to Ku.Sharada Paradkar and remaining amount of Rs.14,40,000(Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Forty Thousand) will be paid in cash before the end of August every year at same rate.

4) Ku.Sharada Paradkar will not make any claim against the Government towards salary for the period commencing from 27/07/2016 till the date of her retirement (on 31/03/2026).

5) Ku.Sharada Paradkar will submit the proposal for pension and post-retirement benefits to the Institution/Society and after verifying the proposal the Institution/Society will submit it to the Assistant Director, Other Backward Class and Bahujan Welfare Department, Gondia. Then the concerned Department will take necessary action and submit it to the Government.

6) Ku.Sharada Paradkar will be given all entitled post-retirement benefits liable to be granted by the Government

Both parties will cooperate each other to complete the abovementioned process and will abide by these terms and conditions.

The petitioner will withdraw the petition pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court."

3. However, during our interaction with Ms. Sharda, she expressed an apprehension that the amount agreed is payable annually in installments and the entire payment shall take

nearly three more years.

4. We have put her apprehension to Mr. Abhay Patil, Secretary of the appellant-Institution, to which, Mr. Abhay Patil agreed before us that the remaining four installments will be paid within a period of next thirty months i.e., the entire amount shall stand paid to her, on or before February, 2029. It has also been agreed that the installments will be paid once in every eight months and in any event, the last installment will be paid on or before 28.02.2029. Ms. Sharda is agreeable to the above payment terms.

5. Accordingly, the appeal stands disposed of as having been settled in the above terms.

6. We record our appreciation for the learned counsel appearing for the parties, Secretary, DLSA, Gondia and Secretary, appellant-Institution for having positively approached the matter and having worked out the settlement.
