CR's Mumbai Division shatters records-surpasses previous best with Ticket Checking Earnings of Rs.16.13 crores during April-2026
 Central Railway's Mumbai Division Ticket Checking Staff has shattered previous records by registering Ticket Checking Earnings of Rs.16.13 crores for the month of April-2026. This remarkable feat sets a new all-time high for monthly ticket checking earnings, surpassing the previous record of Rs.14.50 crores registered in May-2023. During April-2026, Mumbai Division's Ticket checking teams have detected and penalised 2.27 lakh cases of irregular travel in Mail & Express trains and Suburban trains including AC locals as against 1.45 lakh cases in April-2025 registering an increase of 56%. An amount of Rs.16.13 crores was recovered as penalty during April 2026 as against Rs.6.07 crores recovered as penalty in April-2025 registering a significant increase of 166%.

Tata Power launches social welfare initiatives to benefit over 4,000 locals in and around Bhivpuri, Karjat
 Tata Power reaffirmed its commitment to inclusive growth and community development near its 1,000 MW Pumped Storage Project site with the launch of a suite of social welfare initiatives spanning education, skill development and healthcare at Gaulwadi Madhyamik Vidyalaya, Bhivpuri, Karjat. Approximately 1,600 students stand to benefit from enhanced learning infrastructure, the new science laboratory, multipurpose hall and RO plant at Gaulwadi Madhyamik Vidyalaya (~1,000 students), and computers, printers, UPS, benches and sports equipment distributed to nearby schools (~600 students).
