UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Dhruv Mehta, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent-Indian Banks Association, at length.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Punjab National Bank seeks time to file additional affidavit along with additional documents elaborating

upon the issues raised in the Court,

The respondents shall, in particular, respond to the submission advanced by learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) that the updation provided under Clause 35(i) of the 1995 Regulations, as amended in 2002, would apply across the board to all employees, and that such updation has not been extended while computing the pension payable to the retired employees on an annual basis.

The additional affidavit shall also contain the 7th Bipartite Settlement onwards up to the 12th Bipartite Settlement, particularly in relation to the merger of Dearness Allowance for the purpose of calculation of pension, along with the corresponding Joint Notes.

The relevant extracts of the aforesaid Bipartite Settlements may be filed and it shall not be necessary to file the entire settlements, which shall be kept available with learned counsel.

List these matters again for further hearing on 12th August, 2026, as PART-HEARD.
