1. Necessary correction to the cause title with regard to the address statement of opposite party No.4 is allowed. Learned counsel for the petitioner shall ensure such compliance in course of the day.
2. A copy of the writ petition with annexures is requested to be served on Mr. Dash, learned counsel appearing for opposite party No.4.
3. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
4. Instant writ petition is filed by the petitioner for a direction to opposite party No.4, in particular, to dispose of second appeal in accordance with law and to communicate the said order to him.



5. A copy of the appeal memorandum is at Annexure-7. Considering the limited grievance of the petitioner with regard to pendency and disposal of the second appeal and the submission of Mr. Dash, learned counsel appearing for opposite party No.4, this Court is inclined to dispose of the writ petition with such a direction to the authority concerned to ensure it at an earliest and within a reasonable period of time.
6. Accordingly, it is ordered.
7. In the result, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to opposite party No.4 to entertain the appeal memorandum as at Annexure-7 and to consider its disposal as soon as possible and in accordance with law.
