01. **I.A. No.11890 of 2026 and W.P.(C) No.18806 of 2026**

The petitioner questioning the levy of penalty for misconduct in view of Clause 2.2.3 and Clause 3.2 of the Marketing Discipline Guidelines, 2022 for LPG Distributorship filed the instant writ petition seeking to invoke provisions of Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India with prayer(s) for grant of following relief(s):-

“In the light of the aforesaid facts and circumstances this Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit the writ application and after hearing the parties be pleased to quash and set aside the Impugned Speaking Order dated 19.05.2025 as under Annexure-4, in the interest of justice, equity and fairplay;
