VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. In the present civil writ petition, following prayers have been made:-

“a. Issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondent No.2 to designate a Nodal Agency for Sector 70, Faridabad / relevant planning unit by exercising powers under Clause 4.1 of the Policy dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P – 6) in order to implement the construction and operation of 24 meter wide ‘Sectoral Plan Road’, within such time as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper, preferably not later than a period of three (3) months for the date of order.

b. Further issuance of writ of mandamus directing Respondent No. 2 to mandatorily designate any public authority viz Respondent No. 3 or Respondent No. 4 a nodal agency in term of clause 4.1 dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-6).

c. Further writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the Respondent

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No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 18.03.2026, preferred by the Petitioner, within such time as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper, preferably not later than a period of two (2) weeks for the date of order.

- d. FILING of Certified copies of Annexures may be dispensed with;*
- e. PERMIT to place on record the photocopies of the Annexures and further exempt from filing the true typed copies of the Annexures;*
- f. Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the appointment of nodal agency is envisaged under Clause 4.1 of the policy dated 21.08.2015, which policy has been annexed as Annexure P-6, in order to implement the construction and operation of 24 meter wide 'Sectoral Plan Road'. It is submitted that to highlight the said fact, the detailed representation dated 18.03.2026 has been given to the Director General, Town & Country Planning Department, Haryana (respondent no.2) and submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent no.2 considers the said representation and takes action in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider the points mentioned in the representation dated 18.03.2026 as expeditiously as possible and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.



4. It is made clear that that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and the respondent no.2 would consider and decide the representation independently, in accordance with law.
