According to petitioner, she belongs to Economically Weaker Section and is entitled to Tuition Fee Waiver as per the Scheme introduced by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). Petitioner relies upon Clause 6.42 of Approval Process HandBook 2024-2027 issued by AICTE, for claiming Tuition Fee Waiver. 7. It is not in dispute that petitioner was given admission in Women Institute of Technology, Dehradun (<i>respondent no. 6</i>) in B.Tech (Computer Science) in July, 2026, however, benefit of Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme has not been given to her.



			8. Learned counsel for Women Institute of Technology submits that Uttarakhand Technical University allotted petitioner for admission against General category and not against Economically Weaker Section category. 9. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Registrar, Uttarakhand Technical University as well as Director, Women Institute of Technology to examine petitioner's claim for benefit of Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme, as per law, within three weeks from the date of presentation of certified copy of this order.
