Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Part A (B) of Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (SEBI LODR Regulations), we are pleased to inform you that **Rochem Separation Systems (India) Private Limited, a material wholly owned subsidiary of the Company**, has secured an order of **INR 126 crores** from one of the India's oldest and most respected integrated steel manufacturers, for the installation of **Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) systems**.
