O R D E R

1. After arguing the case for some time, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the application for permission to file the Special Leave Petition as he wants to approach the High Court through a review application. Ordered accordingly.

2. The application for permission to file the special leave

petition as well as the main case are, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.

3. Mr. Anil Kaushik, learned Additional Solicitor General of India along with Mr. Shrirang B. Varma, learned counsel, have entered appearance on behalf of the State of Maharashtra. It is pointed out that the State has also proposed to file a Special Leave Petition, being aggrieved by paragraphs 57 and 58 of the impugned judgment.

4. In our considered view, no adverse order has been passed against the State. It is only owing to the conduct of the officer that he has been ordered to be removed with express liberty to the State to appoint a new competent authority.

5. That being so, the State shall be at liberty to notify a new competent authority in accordance with paragraph 63 of the judgment.
