O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Vishwendra Verma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel submits that after the impugned order was passed on 30th April, 2026, the petitioner has deposited 20% of the fine amount on 2nd May, 2026 before the Trial Court.

3. Considering the fact that the petitioner has deposited the amount, we re-instate the order of stay on operation of the sentence imposed, as passed on 8th October, 2025 by the High Court.
