- 1** In continuation of Ministry's General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022, 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 and 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023, 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024, 03/2025 dated September 22, 2025 and other applicable circulars issued in this regard (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") allowed, inter-alia, conduct of AGMs through Video Conferencing/Other Audio-Visual Means ("VC/ AOVN") facility on or before 30th September, 2025 in accordance with the requirements provided in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the MCA General Circular No. 20/2020. The Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") also vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/ CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated 5th January 2023 ("SEBI Circular") has provided certain relaxations from compliance with certain provisions of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"). In compliance with these Circulars, provisions of the Act and the Listing Regulations, the Annual General Meeting of the Company ("AGM") is being held through VC/OAVN without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. The registered office of the Company shall be deemed to be the venue for the AGM.
- 2** In terms of the MCA Circulars, physical attendance of members has been dispensed with and, therefore, there is no requirement for the appointment of proxies. Accordingly, the facility of appointment of proxies by members under Section 105 of the Act will not be available for the AGM. However, in pursuance of Section 112 and Section 113 of the Act, representatives of the members may be appointed for the purpose of voting through remote e-Voting through Board Resolution/Power of attorney/Authoring Letter, etc. for participation in the AGM through VC/OAVN facility and e-Voting during the AGM and since the AGM is being held through VC/OAVN facility, the Route Map is not enclosed in this Notice.
- 3** The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVN mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation in the AGM through VC/OAVN will be made available for 1000 members on first come served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more Shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairperson's of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
- 4** Participation of members through VC will be reckoned for the purpose of quorum for the AGM as per Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("The Act")
- 5** Details of the Directors seeking re-appointment is provided in this Notice.
- 6** Members of the Company under the category of Institutional Investors are encouraged to attend and vote at the AGM through VC. Corporate Members intending to authorize their representatives to attend the AGM pursuant to Section 113 of the Act, are requested to send to the Company, a certified copy of the relevant Board Resolution together with the respective specimen signatures of those representative(s) authorized under the said resolution to attend and vote on their behalf at the meeting.
- 7** 1. Subject to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, dividend as recommended by the Board of Directors, if declared at the Meeting, will be paid within the time prescribed under law, to those Members whose name appear on the Register of Members as on 23rd September, 2026. The dividend for the shares held in dematerialized form, will be paid to the Members whose names are furnished by National Securities Depository Limited and Central Depository Services (India) Limited as beneficial owners as on that date. In view of the circular issued by SEBI, the Electronic Clearing Services (ECS/NECS) facility should mandatorily be used by the companies for the distribution of dividend to its members. In order to avail the facility of ECS/NECS, Members holding shares in physical form are requested to provide/update bank account details to the Registrar and Share Transfer Agent or Company. Members holding shares in electronic form are hereby informed that bank particulars registered against their respective depository accounts will be used by the Company for payment of dividend. The Company or its Registrar cannot act on any request received directly from the Members holding shares in electronic form for any change of bank particulars or bank mandates. Such changes are to be advised only to the Depository Participant of the Members. Pursuant to the Finance Act, 2020, dividend income will be taxable in the hands of Shareholders w.e.f. April 1, 2020 and the Company is required to deduct tax at source from dividend paid to Shareholders at the prescribed rates of the Income Tax Act, 2025. The Shareholders are requested to update their PAN with the Company or its Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (in case of shares held in physical mode) and Depositories (in case of shares held in demat mode).

- 8** In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Act, Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of the Listing Regulations, (including any statutory modification(s) or amendment(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) and various MCA Circulars, the Company is pleased to provide its Members with the e-Voting facility to exercise their right to vote on the proposed resolutions electronically. For this purpose, the Company has appointed Cs Jaymin Piyushbhai Modi proprietor of M/s. Jaymin Modi & Co., as the Scrutinizer for conducting the e-Voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
- 9** The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Act.
- 10** The Company has engaged National Securities Depository Limited (“NSDL”) as the agency to provide the e-Voting facility and the instructions for e-Voting are provided as part of this Notice.
- 11** The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the Cut-Off Date i.e., **Wednesday, 23rd September 2026**.
- 12** As per Regulation 40 of SEBI Listing Regulations, as amended, securities of listed Companies can be transferred only in dematerialized form with effect from April 1, 2019, except in case of request received transmission or transposition and re-lodged transfer of securities. Further SEBI/HO/MIRSD/RTAMB/CIR/P/2020/236 dated December 2, 2020 had fixed March 31, 2021 as the cut-off date for re-lodgement of transfer deeds and the shares that are re-lodged for transfer shall be issued only in demat mode. In view of this and to eliminate all risks associated to physical shares and for ease of portfolio management. Member's holding shares in physical form are requested to consider converting their holding to dematerialized form. Members can contact the Company or the Company's Registrar and Transfer Agent for assistance in this regard.
- 13** Members who are holding shares in identical order or names in more than one folio are requested to write to the company to enable the company to consolidate their holdings in one folio.
- 14** The Register of Members and Share Transfer Register in respect of equity shares of the Company will remain closed from **Thursday, 24th September 2026** to Wednesday 30th September 2026 (both days inclusive).
- 15** In furtherance of Green Initiative in Corporate Governance by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the Shareholders are requested to register their email id with the Company or with the Registrar and Transfer Agent (RTA).
- 16** Members are requested to intimate changes, if any pertaining to their name, postal address, email address, telephone/mobile number, Permanent Account Number (PAN), mandates, nominations, power of attorney, etc. to their DP's if the shares are held in electronic Form and to RTA if the shares are held in physical form.
- 17** Pursuant to Section 72 of the Companies Act, 2013, members holding shares in physical form are advised to file nomination in the prescribed Form SH-13 with the Company's share transfer agent. During this period members of the Company, holding shares as on the cut-off date of **Wednesday 23rd September 2026**, may cast their vote by remote e-voting. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by the member, the member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of "Two Steps" which are mentioned below:



Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

A) Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. 2. Select “”Even” of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period and casting your vote during the General Meeting. For joining virtual meeting, you need to click on “VC/OAVM” link placed under “Join Meeting”.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on “Submit” and also “Confirm” when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.

7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

3. Alternatively, shareholder/members may send a request to evoting@nsdl.com for procuring user id and password for e-voting by providing above mentioned documents
4. In terms of SEBI circular December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are required to update their mobile number and email ID correctly in their demat account in order to access e-Voting facility.
