1. This Application has been filed under Section 19(2) read with Section 70 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 seeking directions against the suspended directors to extend cooperation and hand over the books of account, records, assets and information of the Corporate Debtor to the Interim Resolution Professional.
2. The Applicant submits that, despite repeated communications dated **12.06.2026**, **16.06.2026**, **26.06.2026**, **27.06.2026**, **01.07.2026** and **02.07.2026**, the Respondents have failed to hand over the records and information required for conduct of the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process. It is further submitted that the Statutory Auditor and Forensic Auditor have also reported non-cooperation by the Respondents.
3. Section 19 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 mandates the personnel and suspended management of the Corporate Debtor to extend all assistance and

cooperation to the Interim Resolution Professional. The material placed on record shows that, despite repeated requests, the Respondents have not furnished the documents and information required for conducting the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process.

4. Having considered the submissions and the material placed on record, we are of the prima facie view that the Application requires consideration.
5. Therefore, Issue notice to Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 by the Registry returnable on the next date. The Applicant shall serve Notice through all permissible modes, including e-mail, speed post and hand delivery, if available. The Applicant shall file an affidavit of service at least 03 days before the next date of hearing.
6. Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 shall file their reply, if any, within two days from the date of receipt of notice, with an advance copy to the Applicant.
7. List the matter on 20.07.2026 for further consideration.
