Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and having gone through the materials on record, we are of the view that the petitioner could be said to have frustrated the Order passed by the High Court impugned before us dated 3rd October, 2024. Despite the High Court directing the Respondents, more particularly, the Customs Department to release the goods subject to furnishing of surety bonds equivalent to the value of the goods

till this date, the goods have not been released.

4. We also take notice of the fact that the goods in question are perishable.

5. The High Court shall see to it that the Order passed almost two years back is given effect to in its letter and spirit.

6. With the aforesaid, Special Leave Petition is dismissed.
