**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Leave granted.
2. The operation of the impugned order¹ dated 28th April, 2026 shall remain stayed unconditionally for a month from date.
3. If within this period, the appellant(s) secures the amount due and payable under the impugned order by depositing the same with the Registry, the stay

shall continue until further orders.

4. Once the amount is deposited, the Registry is directed to invest the same in a short-term fixed deposit interest bearing account of a nationalized bank on auto renewal basis, to be operative till such time further order to the contrary is passed.
5. Learned counsel appearing for the first respondent is granted four weeks' time to file counter affidavit.
6. Rejoinder thereto, if any, may be filed by two weeks thereafter.
7. Re-list the civil appeal after eight weeks.
8. In the event the deposit is not made, grant of leave shall stand revoked and the special leave petition shall stand dismissed.
