A W A R D

1. Petitioners, who happen to be claimants in a petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and the respondent no.1-insurance company have agreed to settle the *inter se* dispute.
2. The terms of settlement dated 18th August, 2026 records that the respondent no.1 shall pay Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees eight lakh) only to the petitioners towards full and final payment of all their claims and demands.
3. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of requiring the respondent no.1 to make payment of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees eight lakh) only [over and above Rs.32,68,000/- (Rupees thirty two lakh sixty eight thousand) only which

was ordered by the High Court] within one month, failing which this order shall stand recalled and the special leave petition shall revive.

4. The said additional amount shall be deposited with the relevant Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (MACT). The presiding Judge of the MACT shall take appropriate steps in accordance with law to ensure that the same is credited to the petitioners' bank account.

5. The settlement agreement is taken on record and the terms thereof shall form part of this award.

6. In view of the above, the special leave petition stands disposed of.
