O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent no.1, who appears on caveat.

2. Having considered the rival contentions and going through the material on record, we do not find any merit warranting interference in the order impugned. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.

3. After the order was dictated, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed apprehension that the application(s) filed by him before the designated Court under the Maharashtra Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1999 will be kept pending indefinitely.

4. We only observe that such apprehension is misplaced, as it shall always be open to the petitioner to move before the Court concerned where he has filed any application, for its early disposal.
