O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in a similar Special Leave Petition bearing SLP(C) No. 15804/2026, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has allowed three months time to the respondent(s) to frame a scheme for making payment of the amount as directed by the High Court.

2. Mr. K. Rajeev, learned counsel appearing for the respondent(s) on caveat would submit that the present matter is different inasmuch as in the present case, the payment is to be made by the Life Insurance Corporation and not by the Bank.

3. Be that as it may, we are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition on merits.

4. Considering the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of directing the petitioner and the official respondent(s), including the respondent no.10, Life Insurance Corporation, to make payment of the amount, as directed by the High Court, within a period of three months from today.
