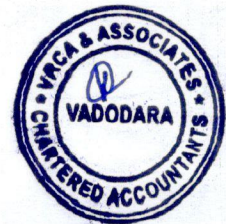
Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of Financial Results of **ANNVRIDHHI VENTURES LIMITED (FORMERLY KNOWN AS J. TAPARIA PROJECTS LIMITED)** ("the company"), for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2026 ("the Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations"). This Statement is the responsibility of the company's management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on this financial Statement based on the Audit.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial statements:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. Give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2026.



Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results* section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial results under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Management's Responsibilities for the Financial Results

The statement has been prepared on the basis of the financial statements. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial results, the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

- The Statement includes the results for the quarter ended 31st March 2026 being the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of full financial year ended 31st March 2026 and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by us, as required under the Listing Regulations.
- The audited financial results dealt with this report has been prepared for filling with the stock exchanges. These results are based on audited financial statement of the company for the year ended 31/03/2026, and should be read together, on which we have issued an unmodified opinion per our report of even date.

2	These Financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standard (Ind-AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Company Act, 2013, read together with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (as amended) and requirement of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.			
3	The previous period figures have been regrouped/reclassified wherever required to conform to the current year's presentation.			
4	The Statutory auditors of the Company have carried out an audit of the above results as per Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirement) Regulations, 2015 and have given an unmodified opinion.			
5	Based on the review by the CODM and the guiding principles given in Ind AS-108 on 'Operating Segments', the Company's business activity fall within a single operating segment i.e Agricultural Food Products.			
6	In the meeting of the Board of Directors of the company ('Board') dated 05.04.2025, the issue of equity shares of the company of face value of Rs. 10 (Rupees Ten only) each ('Equity Shares'), was approved by way of a rights issue for an aggregate amount of Rs. 48.60 Crores, comprising of 3,24,00,000 equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each at a premium of Rs. 5/- each. As informed to BSE on 29.05.2025, the company has resolved to refund to the applicants of the right issue, due to the issue being undersubscribed.			
7	In the meeting of the Board dated 01.11.2025, the issue of equity shares of the company comprising up to 3,78,00,000 partly paid-up equity shares of face value Rs. 10 each at an issue price of Rs. 10 per share, with Rs. 2.50 payable on application and the balance Rs. 7.50 payable on subsequent calls was approved. Pursuant to the issue, the Company allotted 2,96,21,647 partly paid-up equity shares of face value Rs. 10 each to eligible equity shareholders and/or renouncee(s) at an issue price of Rs. 10 per share, aggregating to Rs. 29.62 crores. An amount of Rs. 2.50 per share (aggregating to Rs. 7,40,54,117.50) has been received on application. The balance Rs. 7.50 per share shall be received as and when calls are made in accordance with the terms of the issue. Consequent to the above allotment, the paid-up equity share capital of the Company increased from Rs. 16.20 crores to approximately Rs. 23.60 crores.			
8	Subsequently, the Rights Issue Committee, in its meeting held on 02.03.2026, approved the first call of Rs. 3.50 per partly paid-up equity share (being 35% of the face value of ₹10/- each) on the outstanding 2,96,21,647 partly paid-up equity shares. An amount of Rs. 4,47,19,636.50 has been received after the end of reporting period but before the date of approval of the audited financial results, and the balance amount remains outstanding for collection.

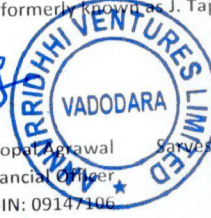
