Profit Before Tax (PBT) for the year stood at ₹50.76 Lakhs and Net Profit After Tax (PAT) was reported at ₹37.20 Lakhs, demonstrating the Company's continued focus on operational efficiency, indigenous drone innovation, and high-value defense applications despite industry-wide challenges and continued investments in research & development.
