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JUDGMENT AND ORDER (ORAL)

1. Mr. P.Dey, learned counsel has entered appearance today on behalf of the respondent No. 2, and Ms. A.D.Syiem, learned GA is present on behalf of the respondents No. 3 & 4, however, none is present on behalf of the respondent No. 1.

2. Mr. P.Dey, learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 today submits that the matter can be closed and the account of the writ petitioner, while keeping the lien amount of ₹6500/-, can be defreezed.

3. Mr. S.Thapa, learned counsel for the petitioner also concurs to the submissions of Mr. P.Dey, learned counsel for the respondent No. 2.



4. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the account of the writ petitioner be defrozen, and only the lien amount of ₹6500/- be kept in abeyance.

5. As ordered above, the writ petition stands closed and disposed of.
