For the Petitioner

1. After going through the writ application, this Court finds that the matter should be filed in the Appellate Side instead of the Original Side. Accordingly, WPO/321/2026 is transferred to Appellate Side. The petitioner is directed to correct the cause title. The Department is also directed to assign the Appellate Side case number.
2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner prays for urgent hearing of the matters as the respondents have passed the impugned orders on 7th July, 2026 directing the petitioner to vacate the unit within five days and five days is going to expire on 12th July, 2026 i.e. on Sunday.
