UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. IA No. 165945 of 2026 seeking intervention and IA No. 165873 of 2026 seeking directions have been preferred by Shri Raghavv Sabharwal, learned counsel for the applicant/intervenor - Nihal Charles Rebello.
2. The intervenor desires early conclusion and solution to the present litigation which involves land over which State Government wants to create a medical hub.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the intervenor argues that a substantial jurisprudential issue of greater importance is involved in the matter to the effect i.e.:-

“If in exceptional situations involving complex factual controversies, where common law procedures or writ remedies are rendered incapable of producing effective and expedient dispute resolution, where arbitration mechanism is not provided, whether Article 142 can be invoked by this Hon’ble Court to fill remedial gaps to enable a court-supervised time bound dispute-resolution reference mechanism having arbitral characteristics, particularly when interests of State or any State Instrumentality (like MMRDA in the instant case) are also involved?”

4. Issue notice on IA No. 165945 of 2026 and IA No. 165873 of 2026.
5. On 22.05.2026, we have directed posting of the main

matter on 12.08.2026. List IA No. 165945 of 2026 and IA No. 165873 of 2026 also on the said date.

6. It is made clear that hearing of the Special Leave Petition shall not be delayed because of IA No. 165945 of 2026 and IA No. 165873 of 2026.
