O R D E R

IA Nos.256209 of 2024, 16412 and 16413 of 2025

Mr. Sanjay Jain, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 has opposed these applications seeking substitution of the legal heirs and survivors of deceased respondent no.1.

The stand taken on behalf of respondent no.1 is that this is not the law that all the legal heirs of a deceased

respondent must be brought on record even where the Will executed by the original respondent does not make them a beneficiary.

At this stage, the Will propounded by the respondent no.1 does not fall for consideration of this Court and the plea based on the recital in the Will cannot be entertained.

Finding sufficient ground to condone the delay, IA No.16412 and 16413 of 2025 are allowed and abatement is set aside.

Legal heirs of the deceased respondent no.1 are brought on record.

Amended memo of parties to be filed within two weeks.

Mr. Sanjay Jain, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 has made a statement in the Court that he is appearing for some of the legal heirs of the deceased respondent no.1. Freshly impleaded respondents in place of respondent no.1 to be served within six weeks.

Four weeks' time is granted for filing the response to the said application.
