This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Appellant e-filed the Memo of Appeal on 10.01.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 17.01.2026, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Appeal on 23.04.2026. It is stated in the IA that despite exercising due diligence, the Applicant/ Appellant and its counsel were constrained by the transit time involved in dispatching and receiving the requisite documents from Guwahati to New Delhi, which resulted in a delay of 89 days in re-filing the present Appeal. The delay occurred purely due to logistical constraints and was neither deliberate nor attributable to negligence or inaction on the part of the Applicant/ Appellant, so the same may be condoned.

Heard learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant and perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Appellant was required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 89 days, hence, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.
