We have heard Learned Counsel for the Appellant and perused the records.

We notice that there are two I.A.'s moved by the Appellant. I.A. No. 6252 of 2026 is with regard to condonation of delay of 13 days and there is another I.A. bearing I.A. No. 6253 of 2026 for impleadment of the SRA.

Notice in I.A. No. 6253 of 2026, has been received by Shri Shambo Nandy. He submits that the other connected appeals pending between the parties are pending before Bench No. 1 and, therefore, this appeal along with the I.A.'s may also be placed before the Bench No. 1.

Learned Counsel for the Appellant, on the other hand, submits that at least notice may be issued with regard to the delay condonation application.

Having regard to the submissions made by Learned Counsel for the Parties, we are of the considered view that, even if all the appeals which are connected with the instant matter may be heard and disposed of by one and the same Bench, however, at least the notice with regard to the delay condonation application and impleadment application may be issued by us.

Since the notice with regard to the impleadment application has been received by Shri Shambo Nandy, he may, file objection, within one week from today as well as with regard to the delay condonation application.

Notice on behalf of the RP has been received by Shri Rishav Banerjee, he prays for, and is granted, one week's time to file the reply with regard to the aforesaid application, with an advance copy to Learned Counsel for the Appellant, who, in turn, if so wish, may file the rejoinder within 5 days thereafter.

We grant liberty to Learned Counsel for the Parties to either move an appropriate application before Bench No. 1 or mention the matter before Bench No. 1 to transfer all the connected cases in one and the same Bench.

Accordingly, list this appeal on **13.10.2026**, under the caption "After Notice".
