O R D E R

1. The petitioners challenge the impugned judgment/order dated 16.10.2025 in Writ Petition No.4043 of 2022 and order dated 28.04.2026 in Review Application *qua* Miscellaneous Civil Application No.937 of 2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature

at Bombay at Nagpur.

2. Delay condoned.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

4. Issue notice, returnable on 21.09.2026.

5. Mr. Aaditya A. Pande, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos.2 and 3. Hence, the formal service of notice on the said respondents is waived.

6. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one (01) week.

7. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondent no.1 is required to file the counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

8. The petitioners to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for respondent nos.2 and 3 immediately.

9. Let counter affidavit be filed by respondent nos.2 and 3 within two (02) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.

10. In the meantime, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in the contempt petition arising out of the impugned judgment/order.
