O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Interim protection from arrest granted to the accused-respondent no. 2 in SLP (Crl.) Diary No. 43983/2026 *vide* order dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2026 in S.B. CRL.

M.P. No.837/2025 and respondent nos.2 & 3 in SLP (Crl.) Diary No. 43983/2026 *vide* order dated 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 in S.B. CRL. M.P. No.7650/2023 are under challenge.

3. We are not inclined to interfere in the exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution; hence, the special leave petitions are dismissed.

4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to pray before the High Court for early hearing of the petition filed by the respondents/accused under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.

5. If at all the records are not traceable in the Registry, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move the Registrar General of the High Court for searching out such records to be placed before the High Court for decision.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
