This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Appellants e-filed the Memo of Appeal on 10.06.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 03.07.2026, intimated the defects to the Appellants on the same day. The Appellants re-filed the Appeal on 19.08.2026. It is stated in the IA that the delay in re-filing was occasioned solely due to procedural compliances and administrative formalities, including compliance with the Registry's objections. The Appellant acted diligently and bona fide at every stage and there has been neither any intentional nor deliberate delay in prosecuting the present Appeal. Unless the delay in re-filing is condoned, the Appellant will suffer grave prejudice, as the Appeal may not be considered on merits despite substantial compliance with the Registry's objections. Also a substantial public revenue is involved in the present matter and grave prejudice shall be caused to the Applicant/Appellant in case the delay is not condoned, whereas no prejudice shall be caused to the Respondent if the delay is condoned. Hence, there is delay of 41 days in re-filing the Memo of Appeal, so the same may be condoned.

None appeared for the Appellants. Perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Appellants were required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellants re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 40 days, hence, the case be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.
