O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. Disputes that arose between the parties way back in 2017 leading to constitution of Arbitral Tribunal have been inconclusive and continue unabated till today. The present civil appeal arises out of a judgment and order passed by the High Court in the context of substitution of the Arbitrator.
3. Mr. Nakul Dewan, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant and Mr. Gagan Gupta, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent, have taken instructions from their respective clients and request this Court to appoint a new Arbitrator so that the disputes could conclusively and expeditiously resolved.
4. Having accepted their request, we set aside the judgment and order passed by the High Court and refer the disputes to Sole Arbitration to be conducted and concluded by Justice Sahidullah Munshi, former Judge, High Court of Calcutta, under the Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996. The terms and conditions of the Arbitral proceedings shall be decided by the learned Arbitrator in consultation with the counsels. The Arbitrator shall commence the proceedings from the stage at which it was left in the previous proceedings. All questions of law and fact are kept open for the parties to raise and contest before the Arbitral Tribunal.

5. With these directions, the civil appeal stands disposed of.

6. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, is/are disposed of.
