UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Guru Krishna Kumar, learned senior counsel and Mr. Vishesh Vijay Kalra, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. P.S.Patwalia,

learned senior counsel appearing for the respondents.

2. After hearing the matter for some time, we put it to the learned counsel for the parties that it was eminently a fit case where an amicable solution to put a quietus to all the pending disputes between the parties arising out of a consent decree, should be explored through the process of mediation. Both the parties, on instructions, have favourably responded to the suggestion, without prejudice to their rights and contentions.

3. We also put it to learned senior counsel for the petitioners that, as a pre-requisite, unconditionally the amount of Rs.12,00,00,000/- (Rupees twelve crores) deposited in this Court, pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15th October, 2025 would be released to the two respondents, with accrued interest, in equal proportions.

4. We direct that the amount of Rs.12,00,00,000/- (Rupees twelve crores) with accrued interest lying in this Court will be unconditionally released to the two respondents equally.

5. The Registry shall release the amount of Rs.12,00,00,000/- (Rupees twelve crores) with accrued interest to the respondents after due verification of their identity.

6. Considering the nature of the dispute, we request Justice Sanjay Vijaykumar Gangapurwala, former Chief Justice of the Madras High Court to act as the Mediator.

7. The parties shall get in touch with the learned Mediator. The fee and other terms of the mediation shall be fixed in consultation with the learned Mediator.

8. A copy of this order shall be forwarded to Justice Sanjay Vijaykumar Gangapurwala, former Chief Justice of the Madras High Court.

9. List the matter on 13th October, 2026 at 2.00 p.m.
