Sub.: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (“SEBI Listing Regulations”) at Bajaj Electricals Limited (“Company”)

Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 30 (read with sub-para 8 of Para B and/or sub-para 20 of Para A, Part A of Schedule III) of the SEBI Listing Regulations, and in line with the Company’s Policy on the Determination of Materiality for Disclosure of Events or Information, and further to our letter dated August 31, 2024, [wherein the Company had, inter alia, intimated about the receipt of an order dated August 31, 2024, under Section 73 of the CGST/TGST Act, 2017 (“Order”), from the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Secunderabad STU-1, Telangana (“GST Authority”), alleging that the Company has claimed excess input tax credit (ITC) during FY 2019-20, and consequently, a total demand of Rs. 16.42 lakh has been imposed on the Company, which includes a general penalty of Rs. 1.49 lakh], we hereby would like to provide an update as follows:

- We are now in receipt of an adverse Order in Appeal dated May 15, 2026 (received by the Company on May 15, 2026, at 03:06 p.m.), issued by the Joint Commissioner, Secunderabad, Telangana (“Appeal Authority”), whereby the Appeal Authority has not considered our submission made and dismissed the appeal.

The management is evaluating appropriate legal remedies available under law, including filing an appeal before the appropriate appellate tribunal and/or initiating writ proceedings before the Hon’ble High Court against the Appeal Order.

The financial impact of the Appeal Order, if materialises, would be limited to the extent of the demand raised and penalty levied thereunder. There is no impact on the operational, financial, or other activities of the Company on account of this order/assessment.

We request you to take the above on record and treat it as compliance under the applicable provisions of the SEBI Listing Regulations, if any.
