Vide Order dated 12.05.2026, the Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 were directed to remain present in person. The Respondents have failed to comply with the said order. It deserves to be taken note that the present application has been preferred

by the RP against the non- cooperation by the Respondents/ Suspended directors. The Corporate Debtor was subsequently ordered to be liquidated. Even the Liquidator is pressing the present IA preferred by the RP stating that no cooperation is being extended; On the other hand, it is submitted that the attempt on the part of the Respondents have been to mislead the Liquidator. There is stated to be no corroboration between the tally data provided and the documents shared by the Respondents. The said facts have already been taken note in the earlier order. Keeping in view the misconduct of the Respondents in not cooperating with the RP/ Liquidator coupled with the non- compliance of the Order dated 12.05.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to issue Show Cause Notice to Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 as to why contempt proceedings be not initiated against both of them. Let the reply, if any, be filed by the respondents within a period of 2 weeks from the date of this order. In addition, both the respondents are directed to comply with the order dated 12.05.2026. Posted to 29.06.2026 for further consideration.

Counsel for the applicant prays for an adjournment to place on record certain relevant documents to counter the allegations by the Liquidator stating that the loan advanced was to the related parties.
