UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The tender process has been withdrawn in 2025.
2. The L-1 tenderer challenged the cancellation in a writ proceeding before the High Court which came to be withdrawn. Initially, the petitioner was permitted impleadment in the proceedings. Although the cancellation had been made in 2025, petitioner had not chosen to initiate an independent proceedings earlier.
2. As the petitioner was neither the L-1 bidder nor any LOA had been issued in his favour, we are of the opinion that he is unable

to make out the case of breach of any fundamental right which would entitle him to relief under Article 132 of the Constitution of India.

3. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to participate in accordance with law in any tender proceedings which may be floated in future.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
