In continuation to our earlier intimations dated August 14, 2023 and March 14, 2025, we wish to inform that the Competition Commission of India ('CCI') has passed separate orders in favour of various network hospitals of the Company, holding that no case of abuse of dominant position under Section 4 of the Competition Act, 2002 is made out against them. Accordingly, the matters have been directed to be closed.

The details of any change in the status and / or any development in relation to such proceedings	<p>This is in continuation to our earlier intimations dated August 14, 2023 and March 14, 2025 wherein vide order dated August 31, 2018 the Competition Commission of India (“CCI”), directed Director General (“DG”) to re-investigate healthcare industry w.r.t. the pricing of all medicines, packages and consumables provided by Respondent Hospitals in Delhi (including 6 Max Network Hospitals). DG submitted its report which was challenged by Respondent Hospitals.</p> <p>CCI after considering the supplementary investigation report filed by DG, the Hospital's objections, oral arguments, and written submissions, rejected the DG's findings in relation to abuse of dominant position.</p> <p>CCI has passed separate orders dated May 21, 2026 in favour of various Max Network hospitals, holding that no case of abuse of dominant position under Section 4 of the Competition Act, 2002 is made out. Accordingly, the matter is closed with no adverse order.</p> <p>The orders were received by the Company on May 21, 2026 at 9.47 pm (IST).
