These are the applications for modification of the order dated 13.02.2026.

Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that in the connected matters the component of interest has not been factored into.

In our considered view, in the connected matters even if the applicant(s) have not been directed to deposit the component of interest, there is no need for modification of order dated 13.02.2026, as there is no uniformity that is required in passing the interim orders.

Furthermore, the aforesaid order which has been passed is more equitable, as the payment of interest follows the principal amount and in any case, the same was passed without prejudice to

the contentions of the parties.

Taking note of the above, we are not inclined to allow these applications. However, a further period of four weeks is given for compliance of our order.

The applications stand dismissed accordingly, by extending the time a further period of four weeks for compliance, if not already made.
