The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 25.06.2015 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No.5. Further, a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to release the benefits of pension, gratuity and leave encashment to the petitioner with interest.
