1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Bank.
 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some times realizing his difficulty, seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail application with liberty to the petitioner to surrender and seek regular bail.
 3. Permission is accorded.
 4. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is dismissed as withdrawn.
 5. However, it is made clear that if the petitioner surrenders and seeks regular bail, the learned Trial Court shall



consider the case on its own merit without being prejudiced by the fact that petitioner before this Court withdrew the anticipatory bail application.
