UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The appeal is admitted.
2. For a period of a month from date, there shall be unconditional stay of the order under appeal.

3. If, within the said period of a month, the appellant deposits Rs.3,19,58,500/- with the Registry of this Court, strictly without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, the order of stay shall continue till the disposal of the appeal.

4. Should there be a default in deposit, the order shall stand vacated and it shall be open for the respondent to move the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission for having the order passed by it executed by instituting appropriate proceedings.

5. However, upon the deposit being made, the Registry shall invest the same in a short-term interest bearing fixed deposit account of a nationalized bank on auto renewal basis and shall keep the account renewed until further orders to the contrary are passed by this Court.

6. Counter affidavit be filed within four weeks.

7. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

8. We reject the prayer of Mr. Kohli, learned senior counsel for the respondent, for release of a part of the deposit to be made by the appellant in terms of this order in its favour, at this stage.
