Upon hearing the counsel, the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. By the order dated 22.07.2026, this Court has requested the Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) to constitute a Medical Board for examining the respondent No.1 regarding the alleged ailment which he is suffering from and the possible treatment which can be admissible to him either in India or abroad. The report of the Board was to be submitted within a period of six weeks.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent(s) submitted that the respondent No.1 has visited the AIIMS and he was there for three days, however, the examination could not be done.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid, we again request the Director, AIIMS to constitute a Medical Board to examine the respondent No.1, as directed earlier, and furnish a detailed report.

4. The respondent No.1 shall appear before the Medical Board on 21.09.2026 and the Director, AIIMS shall also provide accommodation to the respondent No.1, meaning thereby, keep him as an indoor patient and provide accommodation at AIIMS.

5. It is needless to mention that the entire

expenditure to be incurred by the respondent No.1 for getting examined at AIIMS, shall be borne by the petitioner-Insurance Company.

6. List the matters after report from the Medical Board, AIIMS is received.
