ERI AND ECORECO UNVEIL “ERI INDIA” IN TOKYO, MARKING A NEW MILESTONE IN E-WASTE RECYCLING & CIRCULAR RESOURCE RECOVERY

East and West join hands to bring global practices, technologies and Indian capabilities together for the next generation of responsible E-waste recycling, ITAD and resource recovery.

The broader objective is to move beyond the conventional concept of waste management and focus on the **preservation and recovery of the material wealth already embedded in products that society has manufactured and used.**
