A W A R D

1. Heard Ms. Srishti, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mrs. Nanita Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent No.1-Insurance Company

2. The parties have arrived at a settlement during the course of hearing. It is agreed that respondent-Insurance Company shall pay a consolidated amount of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs and fifty thousand) over and above the amount awarded by the High Court to the petitioner in full and final settlement of all his claims. The petitioner agrees that on receipt of the consolidated amount of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs and fifty thousand) over and above the amount awarded by High Court, the petitioner will have no further claim whatsoever against the Insurance Company.

3. The additional compensation of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs and fifty thousand) shall be paid to the petitioner. The petitioner shall furnish the account details to the respondent-Insurance Company. On due verification, the amount of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs and fifty thousand) shall be directly transferred to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

4. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the above terms.

5. We place on record our appreciation for the learned counsel for the parties for the positive and spontaneous response they have shown in settling the matter.
