ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

10.08.2026: This appeal is filed against an impugned order dated 03.06.2026 passed by the learned National Company Law Tribunal, Ahmedabad Bench whereby *I.A. No.493 of 2026* in *I.A. No.128 of 2019* was dismissed. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits they never received any notice of *I.A. No.128 of 2019* in *C. P. No.46 of 2017* as they had changed their address on 01.03.2019. The impugned order shows the service was effected on address mentioned in the MCA website. Though, the learned counsel for the Appellant has shown us Form No. *INC 22* for change of address of the company but it is not mentioned as to on which date it was filed. He has also referred to the rent agreement dated 01.03.2019 which notes the possession was taken from 01.03.2019 but rent agreement was notarised only on 08.03.2019. Further he submits financial transaction was in fact made with 'Vision Procon' which has nothing to do with Appellant company i.e.

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‘Vision Procon Pvt. Ltd.’ and both of these units are not related to each other and it could be a case of mistaken identity.

2. In these circumstances, issue notice to Respondents. Requisites along with process fee, if not filed, be filed within three days. Let reply be filed by the Respondent within three weeks from today. Rejoinder be filed within two weeks thereafter.

3. List this appeal on **09.10.2026**.
