O R D E R

Civil Appeal No(s). 8118/2023

1. The learned counsel for the appellant prays for opportunity to implead the auction purchaser.
2. Permission to implead the auction purchaser is granted.
3. Necessary steps in that regard be taken within a week.
4. If steps are taken as above, notice shall be issued to the newly impleaded respondent, returnable in four weeks.
5. List this appeal after six weeks.

I.A. No. 217215/2026 in C.A. No. 8118/2023

1. Shri Sandeep Sudhakar Deshmukh, learned counsel, who has represented the second and third respondents i.e. the liquidator and the management of the corporate debtor respectively, seeks a discharge from representing them on the ground that they have not provided any instructions.
2. As we find that the necessary party is the auction purchaser and we have already permitted the appellant to implead the auction purchaser, this application is allowed.
3. The learned counsel representing the second and

third respondents is hereby discharged from his responsibility to represent the second and third respondents.

C.A. No. 5702/2025

1. Having regard to fact that the auction purchaser is already represented as the third respondent as reflected in the array of parties, we do not deem it necessary to direct issuance of fresh notice to the unserved respondent nos. 1 and 2.
